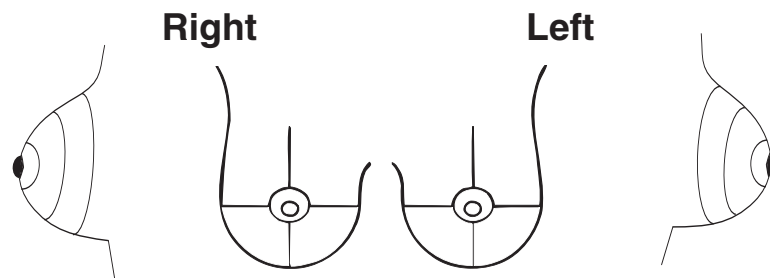

* Related testing may include mammographic and ultrasound tests as well as ultrasound guided biopsies, where appropriate.

1. Biopsies may not be performed on same day as diagnostic testing; patient must schedule any requested ultrasound evaluation in addition to scheduling a mammogram.
2. Patient may require another prescription if more than 6 months have elapsed since last prescription.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO

- ✓ Not wear any deodorant perfume, powder or lotion in the area of the breasts or underarms on the day of your appointment. Any of these might cause shadows to appear on the mammogram.
- ✓ Wear clothing like a blouse or sweater with slacks or a skirt that will allow you to undress easily from the waist up.
- ✓ Bring your previous original mammograms and other breast imaging studies and their reports. Also include pathology reports if you have had a breast biopsy.
- ✓ Bring a form of identification (drivers license), the prescription from your physician and insurance card on the day of your appointment.
- ✓ Verify if your insurance company requires a referral or preauthorization for a procedure and bring it with you on the day of your appointment. This requirement can be verified by calling the 800 number provided on your insurance card.

The Jacqueline M. Wilentz Comprehensive Breast Center is located on Centennial Drive, directly behind Monmouth Medical Center. The Breast Center is easily accessible by car, train, and bus. Free parking is available in the front and in the lots on either side of the building.

From Points North and South: (GSP, Route 18, Routes 35 and 36)

Take the Garden State Parkway (Exit 105), Route 18 (Exit 13B) or Route 35 to Route 36 East. Stay on Route 36 until you reach Broadway. Make a right onto Broadway and proceed south until you reach 3rd Avenue. Make a right onto 3rd Avenue then proceed until you reach Centennial Drive. Make left onto Centennial Drive which will bring you in front of the JMWCBBC.

Via Mass Transit:

The Long Branch train station is located on Third Avenue across the street from the JMWCBBC at Monmouth Medical Center. Service is available on NJ Transit's North Jersey Coast Line.
